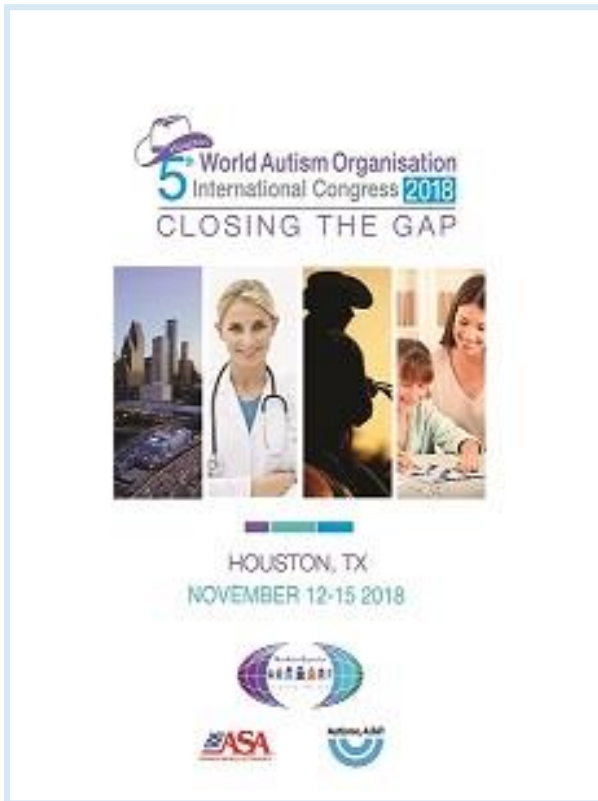


“Save the Date”

The **World Autism Organisation (WAO)** is a voluntary, chiefly but not exclusively, parent-based body that was founded in 1988 with its primary focus being to promote among all people and nations, the highest possible quality of life for people with an Autism Spectrum Condition and their families.

Every four years, the WAO hosts a large international congress in a region where there is a low availability of resources and whose neighbouring regions are also in need of the establishment of services and support.

In November 2018, the WAO will host their 5th International Congress in Houston, Texas, with support from the American Society for Autism, and in partnership with Nuevo Leon Parent Organisation from Mexico.

Historically, 1200 -1500 people attend the WAO international congresses, most of which boast over 120 speakers, an extensive range of poster presentations, as well as educational and informative exhibitions. All these contributions culminate in a far-reaching and beneficial impact for the people of the surrounding communities, a perfect platform for networking, fellowship and enjoyable socialising amongst all delegates, as well as provide a vital catalyst for knowledge enhancement across the globe.
